**PLAN 91.23 PUBLIC QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS** Applicant for 24/00986/FUL explained that a new access road is needed to avoid loss of income associated with the flooding of existing road and to aid receipt of vital delivery lorries. The proposed road is above the field level and floodline. There should be no significant increase in traffic along the Cruckmeole to Cruckton road.

# 92.2.1 Reference: 24/00845/FUL (validated: 29/02/2024)

**Address**: Newnham Hall, Yockleton, Shrewsbury, Shropshire, SY5 9PX **Proposal**: Erection of general purpose agricultural building to include supplementary cattle housing

**SUPPORT** the proposed development as it is much needed in order to maintain the viability of the farm and the size of the proposed building is appropriate to the identified need. Given the size of the proposed building the council strongly support the proposed landscaping on the eastern side of development.

# 92.2.2 Reference: 24/00986/FUL (validated: 11/03/2024)

Address: Hall Farm, Cruckmeole, Hanwood, Shrewsbury, Shropshire, SY5 8JN Proposal: New access road

**SUPPORT** the proposed development in order to maintain the future viability of the farm and the parish council agrees that there are serious problems with existing access due to frequent flooding and for access for large farm vehicles.

The parish council feel that the chosen route for the road will minimise disturbance to the surrounding trees and the impaction of tree roots.

The parish council are aware of the existing flood issues either side of Cruckton and would ask planning officers to ensure that the proposed application does not worsen these flooding issues and that John Bellis (Shropshire Council Flooding Officer) be included in their deliberations.

Given the loss of existing important hedging the parish council strongly recommend that the new hedge planting is done in line with the Ecology Impact Assessment in order to meet policy GRE 2 of the Pontesbury Parish Neighbourhood Plan. The council recommends that planting be on the south side of the proposed roadway.

**Address**: Earls Hill Barn, Pontesford Hill, Pontesbury, Shrewsbury, Shropshire, SY5 0UH **Proposal**: Removal of Condition No.s 10 and 13 from Planning Permission 03/0999/F dated 11 September 2003

**SUPPORT** removal of conditions 10 and 13. The council appreciates that this is a sensitive area but feel that the removal of the clauses should not result in any significant detriment to the character and amenity of the area.
